Information

DESCRIPTION & ELIGIBILITY

Upon the recommendation of the high-school principal or counselor, high school students who are California residents and have completed their sophomore year of college-preparatory courses with a 3.0 or higher grade point average may enroll at Humboldt State University.

Courses must be at a level beyond what is available at the high school and would not include courses required for high school graduation or eligibility for admission to UC or CSU.

Enrollment is limited, on a space-available basis, to courses appearing in the semester's schedule of classes. Classes available for concurrent enrollment normally are limited to 100-299 course designations, and students are expected to meet established prerequisites for courses. Individual enrollment may be allowed in 300 and higher level courses by instructor permission.

APPLICATION & REGISTRATION

The high school principal or counselor should indicate his/her approval of each of the course(s) requested by signing in the appropriate box(es).

Next, obtain the signatures of the instructor and department chair of the course(s) selected.

Upon obtaining the necessary approvals, the form should be taken to the College of Extended Education & Global Engagement, second floor of the Student Business Services Building.

DEADLINES

The deadline to register and pay fees is the end of the second week of classes.

High School Concurrent students should consult the appropriate semester calendar on the Web (humboldt.edu) for other important dates and deadlines and contact the College of Extended Education & Global Engagement for instructions on how to make adjustments to their schedule (withdrawals, grade mode changes, adds, drops, etc.). Such changes will need to be in writing and may require forms and appropriate signature.

FEES

\$232/unit fee (subject to change without notice) plus any applicable fees which are associated with some courses.

A student identification card may be purchased for \$5.

It is the student's responsibility to pay the required fees at the time of registration to the College of Extended Education & Global Engagement, located on the second floor of the Student and Business Services Building.
